



## Application deadlines

### → Application period for the winter semester

**1<sup>st</sup> June - 15<sup>th</sup> July**

*The winter semester starts in October.*

### → Application period for the summer semester

**1<sup>st</sup> December - 15<sup>th</sup> January**

*The summer semester starts in April.*

EU-citizens can apply for free Bachelor courses until 15<sup>th</sup> October (winter semester) and 1<sup>st</sup> April (summer semester).

**Please apply early!** This will give you enough time to submit any missing documents. Documents receiving after the deadline and incomplete applications cannot be processed!



## Acceptance

### When will I know if I have been accepted?

Letters of acceptance are sent 4 to 6 weeks after the application deadline. As a rule, an acceptance is not valid for a later semester.

# Applying to study at TU Braunschweig

## Entry requirements and application process for international students



## Academic entry requirements

You can apply to study at TU Braunschweig if you:

- ▶ successfully completed secondary school education.
- ▶ passed university entrance exam (if applicable).
- ▶ In some cases, additional qualifications may be required.

### Can I apply for a higher semester?

If you have already successfully completed an identical or similar course of study, you may apply for entrance to a higher semester at TU Braunschweig. The responsible department will decide if and in which semester you can continue your studies.

### What are the entry requirements for Masters programmes?

Minimum requirement is a **Bachelors degree** in the same or a closely related subject. Additional qualifications may be required.

## Language entry requirements

At TU Braunschweig, most programmes are taught in German. Therefore you need to prove a sufficient command of German.

### Proof of your language skills

You should have at least German language knowledge on level B 2.2 (Common European Framework) when you apply. For enrolment you must have passed one of these tests:

- DSH2
- TestDaF (with at least 4 points in each section of the test)
- Feststellungsprüfung of the Studienkolleg
- Sprachdiplom of the Kultusministerkonferenz (Stufe II)
- C2-Zertifikat of the Goethe Institute
- Telc C1 Deutsch Hochschule

### Application process

- 1 Complete and submit the online application form.
- 2 Print the online application form and sign it.
- 3 Compile all the necessary documents.
- 4 Pay the assessment fee, enclose the receipt with your application.
- 5 Send the complete application to the International Office.

### Which documents do I need for application?

You will find a personal checklist with all required documents at the end of the online application process.

#### → A complete application usually includes

- ▶ signed application form (Antrag auf Zulassung)
- ▶ your curriculum vitae
- ▶ a copy of your latest German language certificate
- ▶ receipt for payment of your assessment fee
- ▶ in some cases: school leaving or university certificates, university entrance exam results, transcript of records (each as certified copies in original language accompanied by a German or English translation. Documents in English do not have to be translated.)

### How much will my application cost?

TU Braunschweig charges a fee of € 70 for the assessment of foreign qualifications. In some cases you are exempt from the assessment fee:
